Notes:

1. Also requires a personal interview and reference check by a certified Rotarian
2. Each Club needs to have a minimum of three Certified Counselors (at least one each male and female)
3. An adult is a person who is or will be 18 years of age or older during any contact with youth in a Rotary context
4. All individuals involved in Youth Exchange must be screened annually through reference checks and a NSOR check
